

Notice of Weather and Possible Flooding – March 10, 2016

As you are aware, we will receive a lot of rain in the next few days along with what we have already gotten. Our subdivision drains into the Pontchitolawa and the Tchefuncte. These outlets are backing up already due to many issues involving rain that has fallen elsewhere and the Southeast winds causing high tides that impact their levels. Expect our streets to hold water because the water has nowhere to go. We encourage all to clean any drains around their house. It is also important that we drive slowly through any water that has collected on the streets. Once the waters in the Pontchitolawa and the Tchefuncte recede our water will get out.

Several times before with large amounts of rain some of our streets to exit the subdivision were not passable. Some residents were unable to get out of the subdivision. Be mindful of deep water that might occur on some streets near the River Oaks and Woodberry area.

The good news is that we have never had any water get in any houses in our subdivision over the years. We never know if this will be worse than other rains we have had in the past so be aware of what is going on around your house and your neighbor's house.
