

RIVER OAKS INCIDENT FOLLOW-UP REPORT

We want to give you an update to the incident that occurred in our subdivision on Tuesday, March 21, 2017 involving neighborhood minors, wherein a non-resident 16 year-old male was arrested for resisting arrest. Other incidents were investigated including the perpetrator approaching minor females on multiple occasions on the pretense of asking for directions.

As a result of the investigation conducted by the Sheriff's Department, a warrant was issued for the arrest of the perpetrator. He turned himself in on Friday, March 24th and was incarcerated throughout the weekend. He was charged with two counts of obscenity which is a felony.

River Oaks Board and the Sheriff's Department want to thank all of the residents that provided information. The video provided by River Oaks was key in determining that his vehicle went in and out of the subdivision at the time of other investigated incidents.
