

TRAFFIC CONTROL IMPLEMENTATION

At the 2019 annual homeowners meeting, those present requested that the Board of Directors look into means to control the speed by vehicles on River Oaks Drive. The board at its next regular meeting in April 2019 the Board approved that the Capital committee look into Traffic control alternatives of STOP signs, Speed Humps and Radar Speed indicating devices. At the July 2019 meeting the Board sanctioned a Traffic Control study by a Traffic Engineering firm. This was done as a result of a recommendation from the St Tammany Sheriff's Office (STPSO) and St Tammany Parish Department of Public Works.

St Tammany Sheriff's Office provided Radar Speed Data from two locations – inbound and outbound to the Association. The Association contracted with JV Burkes Engineering to give us recommendations on Traffic Speed Control Alternatives. They used the STPSO data and their knowledge of best practices in speed control to develop recommendation for River Oaks. At the October 2019 the Board approved the implementation of the recommendations of the consultant, JV Burkes. The project will be funded from the "Reserve for Capital Projects" account.
